

Carleton Shores Success Plan for Fourth of July 2021 - Reminders

Please read and familiarize yourself with these key reminder points that will be in place for the 4th of July (or the 5th as a rain date) at Carleton Shores. Be sure to communicate these to your family, guests, and/or renters.

ENTRANCE CHECKPOINT

- There will be a **checkpoint** staffed by All Cape Security at the entrance to Carleton Shores.
- Be sure to **display your Carleton Shores BLUE Parking Tag**; this will facilitate faster access.
- A **password** will be required for anyone entering the neighborhood (by car, foot, bike, etc.) without a Beach Parking Tag.
- **Passwords will be sent via email on July 4th before 7am.** Be sure to only share your password with your visitors.

PARKING

- **Parking will be limited** to one side of Carleton Drive and Carleton Drive East and both sides of Carleton Drive West. Vehicles in the posted No Parking areas are subject to being towed.
- **Do not park on neighbor's lawns/property**, block their driveways, or in No Parking designated areas.
- Consider having guests park at your home and walk to the beach. **Only one car with your BLUE tag number/per home just for 4th to be parked in the lot from 3pm on**; All Cape Security will be monitoring the parking lot.

SAFETY

- **No fireworks are to be launched on the Carleton Shores common beach area.**
- **Follow all fire safety rules.** Small, contained cook fires are permitted with prior approval from the Sandwich Fire Department.
- Extinguish all fires before leaving and remove debris.
- If you have a party on our beach, **clean up afterward.**

BEACH

- The **Carleton Shores Common Beach extends 250 feet on either side of the stairs.** Beach areas adjacent to the common beach belong to the individual beachfront owners.
- **Stay off the dunes** and remind others to do so too.
